Currie Rose Resources Inc. has been informed by the Company's Joint Venture Partner, JML Resources Ltd., it has commenced drilling at the Scadding Gold Property located near Sudbury, Ontario. The focus of the current drill program will be to assess the potential of several new geophysical targets identified in the recently completed geophysical program. JML announced on January 22, 2004 that it had completed a drill program which raised gross proceeds of \$1,012,000 to fund the current exploration program.

The geophysical program consisted of detailed ground magnetics and an induced polarization (I.P.) survey. Seven potential gold bearing target zones were outlined by the geophysics which will be drill tested. Four of these zones represent new targets on the property and the others are on strike extensions of known areas of gold mineralization. The focus of the program is to highlight the potential of the property by intersecting new areas of gold mineralization.

Highlights from the drill program completed by JML in December 2003 included 5.5 meters @ 5.5 g/t gold in JML-01; 7.0 meters @ 9.1 g/t gold in JML-02; 1.5 meters @ 33.7g/t gold in JML-03; 2.0 meters @ 7.8 g/t gold and 5.0 meters @ 5.4 g/t gold in JML-07 and 2.0 meters @ 14.9 g/t gold in JML-11. The exploration program at Scadding is being conducted under the supervision of Ken Lapierre, P.Geo., the Q.P. for JML Resources Ltd.
