High Grade Gold at Scadding

Currie Rose Resources Inc. has been informed by the Company's joint venture partner, JML Resources Ltd. (**TSX-V : JJJ**), of material drill results today from the Scadding Gold Property located near Sudbury, Ontario. A new high grade zone of gold mineralization has been discovered on the property, termed the 17 Zone. A drill program is ongoing to assess the potential of several other new geophysical targets identified in the recently completed geophysical program.

Drilling on the flank of an east west trending IP anomaly intersected an 8 meter wide intensely brecciated zone of chlorite alteration. A 3 meter wide section within the zone containing visible gold and large cubic disseminated pyrite assayed 23.0 g/t gold (0.67 ounces/ton) across 3.0 meters (9.9 feet). Assay results from the initial drill hole in the 17 Zone are tabulated below.

Assays were completed at Laboratoire Expert Inc. in Rouyn-Noranda Quebec using conventional assay techniques.

The current phase of drilling is targeting the remaining untested conductors from the recent geophysical program. Four of eight targets have now been drilled.

One of the three holes targeting Zone 2 intersected visible gold hosted within a new zone of chlorite breccia and pyrite. A one meter intersection starting at 75 meters down the hole intersected 4.64 g/t (0.14 ounces/ton). Follow up drilling is required to follow the extent of gold mineralization in this area.

Drill core from 2 additional holes drilled in two other zones are currently being logged, split and sent for assay. The remaining three priority targets in the 1.5 x 1.5 km grid are in the process of being drilled.
