**Currie Rose Reports Jubilee Reef Results in
Tanzania**

Currie Rose Resources Inc. has been informed by its joint venture partner, Sub-Sahara Resources NL, that drilling at the Jubilee Reef prospect in central Tanzania has been completed. The program consisted of 2,764 metres of drilling including 6 Reverse Circulation (RC) drill holes (JLRR 028 to JLRR 033) totaling 648 metres and 54 Rotary Air Blast /Aircore (RAB/Aircore) (JLRB 429 to JLRB 482) drill holes totaling 2,116 metres.

The RC drill holes targeted specific previously defined targets while the RAB/aircore drill holes targets geochemical anomalies and drill holes were spaced 25m apart.

The Company is especially encouraged by the results on Masabi Hill as they have confirmed gold mineralization over significant widths and this data will add to the overall structural model.

Further drilling will be planned after review of recently acquired Finnish Airborne Geophysical (Magnetic/Radiometric and Electromagnetic) data covering the Jubilee Reef project areas.
