ENCOURAGING RESULTS FROM HELI-MAG SURVEY OF MABALE HILLS PROJECT IN TANZANIA

Harold Smith, President is pleased to announce that the interpretation of the recently completed helicopter-supported Magnetic/Radiometric geophysical survey on the Company's Mabale Hills Joint Venture with ASX listed Sub-Sahara Resources NL, has confirmed the Mwamazengo discovery as a high priority target and has identified 3 new high priority targets for follow-up prospecting and drilling.

The Mabale airborne survey (2,190 line kilometres on 100-metre grid spacing) was initiated to generate additional targets and confirm the local ground magnetic survey completed at Mwamazengo. The survey has delineated dipolar magnetic anomalies that coincide with the known mineralisation at Mwamazengo and covering a strike of over 2.5km. In addition, three 1st order anomalies of similar magnitude have been identified with the most significant of these situated approximately 4km north of Mwamazengo along the same north-south structure and covering approximately 2km of strike.

In addition, the radiometric survey identified granitic intrusives that coincide with mapped granite units and has also identified a number of linear features that that could be related to potassic or sericite alterations or felsic dykes.

Five second order and two third order magnetic anomalies have also been identified on the Mabale block.

All the above targets will be mapped and sampled as soon as possible (currently restricted due to heavy rains) with some ground based geophysics (IP) as a follow up and as a pre-cursor to RAB drilling.

Once completed, the Company will initiate a new round of drilling to investigate the new targets, along with further drilling at the original discovery.
