CURRIE ROSE RESOURCES INC. SIGNS JOINT VENTURE WITH BARRICK IN TANZANIA

Harold Smith, President, is pleased to announce that agreement has been reached with Barrick Exploration Africa Ltd (BEAL) over the 100% owned Jubilee Reef Gold Project situated in the Lake Victoria Gold Field of Central Tanzania.

Under the terms of the agreement, BEAL (a wholly owned subsidiary of Barrick Gold Corp.) has the right to earn 51% of Currie's interest in the Jubilee Reef Project by spending US\$1 million on exploration over a three year period.

BEAL must spend a minimum of US\$300,000 in the first year. If BEAL withdraws prior to spending US\$1 million (but having spent minimum of US\$300,000), it shall be deemed that BEAL has no further interest in the project and the project will be returned to Currie Rose unencumbered.

Once BEAL has earned its 51% interest, Currie Rose can then elect to contribute pro rata to retain its 49% interest or it can allow BEAL to earn an additional 19% interest to bring Beal's interest in the Property to 70% by further funding Expenditure of \$US2,000,000 over 4 years.

Work by BEAL will commence immediately with a project wide airborne geophysical survey.

Jubilee Reef is a key project for Currie Rose. The farm out to BEAL will give the project a much needed expenditure lift and will allow Currie Rose to spend its funds on the Mabale and recently acquired Sekenke projects.
