DRILLING COMMENCES IN TANZANIA

Currie Rose Resources Inc. is pleased to announce that a program consisting of 5,000 metres of Rotary Air Blast (RAB) drilling and Reverse Circulation (RC) drilling has commenced at the Ilalucha prospect that forms part of the Mabale Hills Project in the Lake Victoria greenstone belt of Tanzania.

The Mabale Hills Project is well situated in the Sukumaland greenstone belt that hosts a number of mining and advancing exploration plays including the Geita Gold Mine (AngloGold Ashanti), Kitongo (Iamgold) and Nyanzaga (Barrick-Sub-Sahara Resources).

The Ilalucha prospect has coincident geophysical (helimag) and soil geochemistry anomalies in an area mapped as folded banded iron formation (BIF). A follow-up ground magnetic survey has verified the soil geochemistry and a recent IP survey has defined new targets east of the gold-in-soil targets.

On completing the first pass drilling at Ilalucha, the rig will move to the Manyiro prospect where a strong, gold-in-soil anomaly (currently open to the north east) has been defined. An IP/Resistivity survey has been completed and is currently being processed ahead of drilling.

Further exploration will continue on the other prospects in the immediate area and with positive results, the drilling program will be extended to drill test these areas.
