TWO NEW TARGETS GENERATED AT THE MABALE PROJECT, TANZANIA

Harold Smith, President, Currie Rose Resources Inc., is pleased to announce that the current phase of work has identified two new gold zones within a 5km radius of the Mwamazengo gold discovery. (See map on website, www.currierose.com).

The work consisting of soil geochemistry, ground geophysics and Rotary Air Blast (RAB) drilling has successfully identified a very promising geochemical anomaly of a similar size as that found at Mwamazengo has been generated at Manyiro North, extending for over 500 metres with a peak soil value of 1.8g/t gold with numerous clustered anomalous gold values.

In addition, Rotary Air Blast (RAB) drilling at Ilalucha has identified a near surface low grade zone as follows: MBNM060 – 16 metres grading 0.47 g/t gold from 4 metres.

This depleted near surface zone is very encouraging as many of the known gold occurrences in Tanzania have resulted from a low grade near surface result. Furthermore, the assays indicate broad, low grade mineralisation over the entire drilled width indicating that this result is not related to a single quartz vein.

In addition to the above, IP geophysical surveys have been completed over all of the target areas and close spaced ground magnetic surveys covering all the prospects will be completed over the coming weeks.

The planned Reverse Circulation (RC) drilling was not completed due to mechanical breakdown of the contract drill rig.

This data and the soil geochemistry/RAB assay results will be interrogated prior to the next phase of drilling which will be conducted once an appropriate drill becomes available.

The Mabale Hills Project is well situated in the Sukumaland greenstone belt that hosts a number of mining and advancing exploration plays including the Geita Gold Mine (AngloGold Ashanti), Kitongo (Iamgold) and Nyanzaga (Barrick-Sub-Sahara Resources) and Bulyanhulu (Barrick).
